Denver area voters created the Scientific & Cultural Facilities District (SCFD) in 1988 to provide consistent public financial support for scientific and cultural organizations in the seven-county metro region. Since then, the SCFD has funded over 300 organizations via the 0.1% (1¢ on every \$10) retail sales and use tax in the seven-county district.
